MEETING, APRIL 1 AND 2

The **Alaska Migratory Bird Co-management Council** will conduct its spring meeting April 1 and 2, 2004 at the Kaloa Bldg, 1689 C Street, in Anchorage, Alaska.

The Co-management Council, which includes Alaska Native, State and Federal representatives as equals, was formed March 28, 2000 by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service as required by the amended migratory bird treaties with Canada and Mexico. The Co-management Council will consider proposals to change the 2005 spring/summer subsistence migratory bird harvest regulations and petitions to amend the list of communities eligible for participation in the program.

The meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m. Follow-up sessions will be at the discretion of the Council. Members of the public may comment on agenda items at the beginning and end of the sessions.
