Southeast Alaska Subsistence Regional Advisory Council to Meet in Juneau

The Southeast Alaska Subsistence Regional Advisory Council will meet March 20-22, 2012 at the Elizabeth Peratrovich Hall in Juneau. The meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m.

The Council will develop proposals to change Federal subsistence regulations for the harvest of fish and shellfish. On March 21-22, beginning at 1:00 p.m., the Council will meet jointly with the Federal Subsistence Board to review a petition, submitted by Kootznoowoo, Inc., to exercise extraterritorial jurisdiction over non-Federal marine waters adjacent to Admiralty Island. Following the joint meeting on March 22, the Southeast Alaska Regional Advisory Council will develop a recommendation to the Federal Subsistence Board on the petition.
