### **Closed Area of Federal Subsistence Fishery to be opened in Afognak Bay**

Effective at 10:00 a.m. on Monday 11 June 2012, this Special Action will open much of Afognak Bay to subsistence fishing for salmon, within the waters of Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge. All federal waters of Afognak Bay will be open to subsistence fishing up to the ADF&G markers located at the Afognak River stream terminus in the Southeast Afognak Section. Waters upstream of the ADF&G markers at the Afognak River stream terminus will be closed to subsistence fishing. This boundary change is effective at 10:00 a.m. June 11, 2012, and continues until further notice but no later than 12:01 p.m. August 3, 2012.
