### Notice of Correction to the Area Description for the Portion of Unit 12 that is Closed to Caribou Hunting

The description of the area closed to caribou hunting in Unit 12 under Federal subsistence regulations was incorrectly published omitting “and Preserve”. The following shows the corrected description:

Customary & Traditional Use Determination	Harvest Limits	Open Season
<b>CARIBOU</b>		
Rural residents of Unit 12, Chistochina, Dot Lake, Healy Lake, and Mentasta	Unit 12—that portion within the Wrangell-St. Elias National Park <b>and Preserve</b> that lies west of the Nebesna River and the Nebesna Glacier. All hunting of caribou is prohibited on Federal public lands.	No Federal open season
