**2011 Yukon River Fall Salmon Fishery News Release # 31
Fall Announcement # 26, District 4 Salmon Subsistence Fishing Schedule
Districts Affected: Upper Yukon Area**

District 4: Effective 6:00 p.m. Friday, August 24, subsistence fishing in the entire District 4 will be open 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

District 4 begins three quarters of a mile below Old Paradise Village at the mouth of an unnamed slough and runs upstream to the westernmost edge of Illinois Creek of the Yukon River. This includes the mainstem Yukon River communities of Anvik, Grayling, Kaltag, Nulato, Koyukuk, Galena, and Ruby, as well as the Koyukuk River communities. This schedule is anticipated to remain in effect for the remainder of the season for District 4.
