The Seward Peninsula Subsistence Regional Advisory Council will meet October 3-4 at the Aurora Inn Conference Room in Nome. The meeting will begin at 8:30 a.m.

At this meeting, the Council will review and make recommendations to the Federal Subsistence Board on proposals to change subsistence fisheries regulations. The Council will also review and make recommendations on the proposed changes to Memorandum of Understanding between the Federal Subsistence Board and the State of Alaska. Other issues related to subsistence will be discussed.

The Council represents residents of the Seward Peninsula Region. Public testimony helps the Council formulate its recommendations to the Federal Subsistence Board to best represent the people of the region.
