## **Bristol Bay Subsistence Regional Advisory Council to Meet in Dillingham**

The Bristol Bay Subsistence Regional Advisory Council will meet October 24-25 at the Dillingham City Hall in Dillingham. The meeting will begin at 8:30 a.m.

At this meeting, the Council will review and make recommendations to the Federal Subsistence Board on proposals to change subsistence fisheries regulations. The Council will also review and make recommendations on the proposed changes to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Federal Subsistence Board and the State of Alaska. Other issues related to subsistence will be discussed.

The Council represents residents of the Bristol Bay Region. Public testimony helps the Council formulate its recommendations to the Federal Subsistence Board to best represent the people of the region.
