Federal Subsistence Board Rejects Special Action Request to Further Restrict Kenai Area Subsistence Moose Harvest

The Federal Subsistence Board recently considered a special action request to further restrict moose harvest during the October 20-November 10 season in Units 15B and 15C. The Board voted to reject this special action request; therefore, Federally qualified subsistence users may harvest one antlered bull with spike-fork of 50-inch antlers or with three or more brow tines on either antler during this season. A Federal registration permit is required for this hunt. Permits are available at the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge, Ski Hill Road, Soldotna, Alaska. Due to conservation concerns, a 24 hour reporting period will be required and the harvest will be closely monitored.
