### **PUBLIC MEETING/HEARING TO BE HELD REGARDING THE 2012/2013 FEDERAL MARTEN TRAPPING SEASON ON KUIU ISLAND IN UNIT 3**

The US Forest Service will be holding a public meeting/hearing to discuss Special Action Request 12-09 submitted by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game to the Federal Subsistence Board. This request is to close the Federal subsistence trapping season for marten on Kuiu Island during the 2012-2013 trapping season. This action is being proposed because of continued low abundance of marten in this area.
