Since 1992, the Adopt-A-Stream program has developed stewardship and student appreciation for the aquatic environment through education and experience.

The program involves three area schools and six classrooms of 5-7th graders. Students participate in classroom lessons on water quality, aquatic insects, fish biology, and winter safety. Classes take monthly field trips to local creeks to conduct testing, and review collected data in classroom review sessions.
